Dimond played first grade for Dapto as a 16-year-old

He was chosen to tour with the 1948-49 Kangaroos as an 18-year-old (he turned 19 on tour)

He played two seasons with Western Suburbs (1950-51) but his career was cut short by injury, firstly in a motor bike accident in which he damaged his right leg and suffered severe concussion and secondly when he fractured his wrist in a trial for St George in 1954. He made a brief comeback for Kempsey in 1955 and was chosen for Country Seconds but was forced to withdraw with injury

He was the last surviving member of the 1948-49 Kangaroos
